A lot has happened since the beginning of the school year!

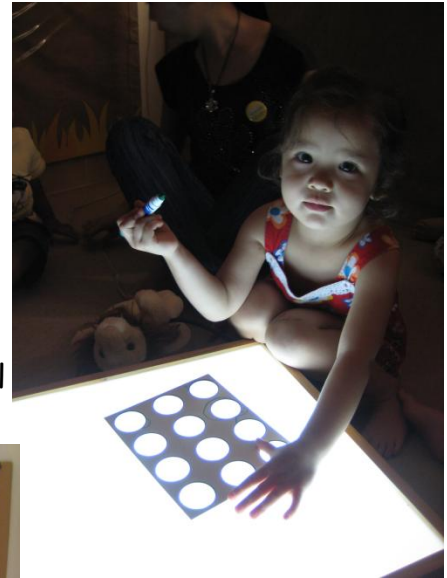
