Learning about our family and our school, all the children had an opportunity to share a family photo with their friends.

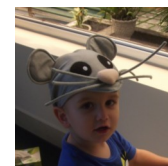

Leonor and Khang explore the school using their binoculars to help them see with their eyes!



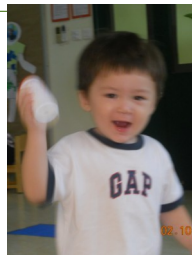
I've had such a wonderful
